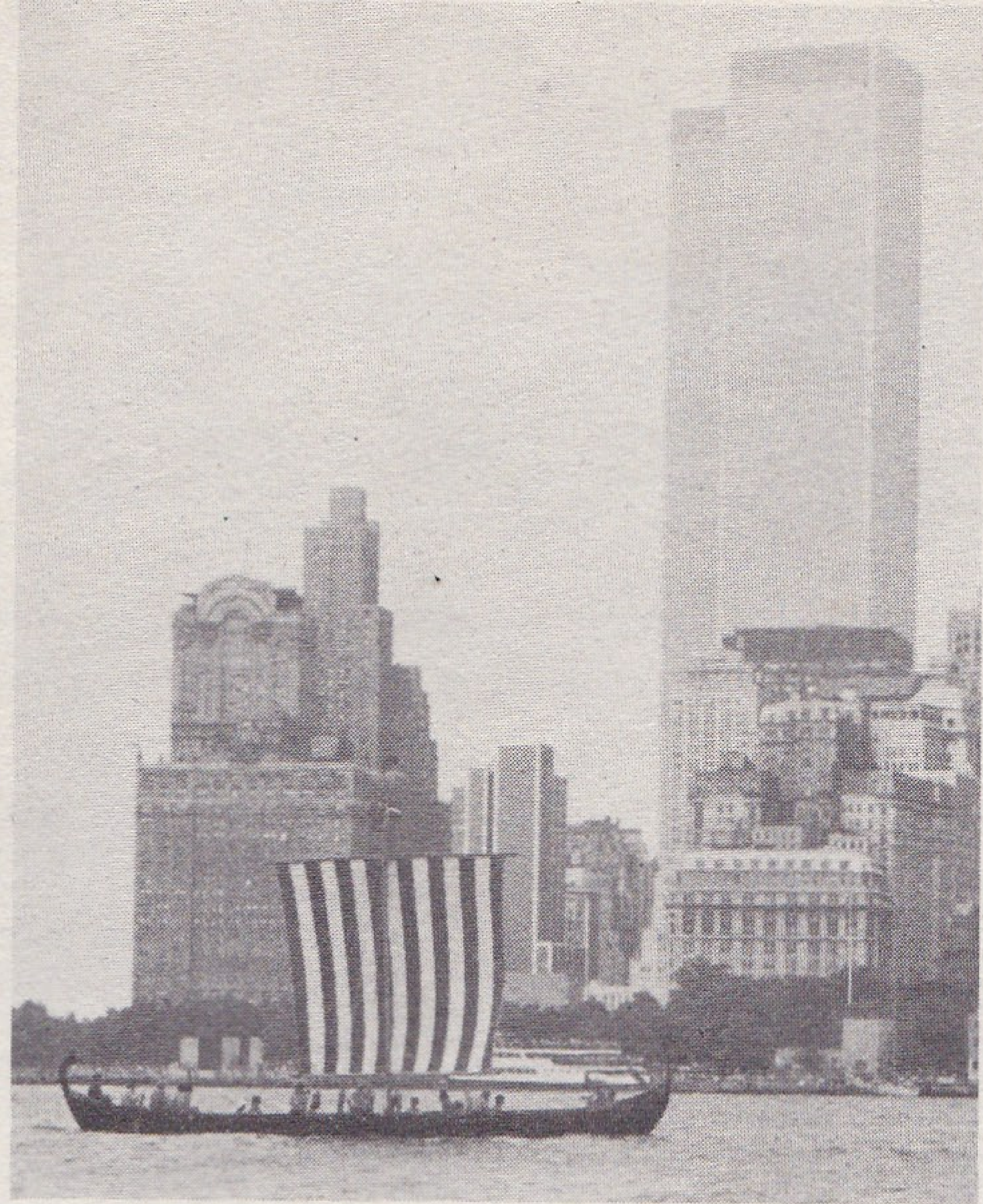


Want to visit Denmark? You may remember the friendly group of 31 Danes who were the guests of several sloop clubs during July of 1976. The Danes had built a replica Viking warship, the Sebbe Als, from scratch, using reproductions of the tools used to build the original ships. After saving their money for long enough, the Sebbe Als crew sailed their boat over here for Operation Sail. They were guests of the Henry Street Settlement House while in New York City, and were hosted by several different sloop clubs during the week they spent sailing up the Hudson.
